
To empower young people to develop essential life skills and build their confidence through interactive and engaging programmes.



Sunnah Trust is a grass-roots organisation established in February 2017, whose sole focus is to **empower young people towards a brighter future**. By providing them with opportunities to build their skills and broaden their horizons, they will have the confidence to make informed decisions and serve themselves and their communities. Our purpose is to **build a cohort of conscious, mobilised individuals** who are ready to take charge.

Servitude - Youth Leadership Programme

'Servitude' is a year-long transformative leadership programme designed to **empower young Muslims** with essential skills and knowledge in core leadership. Powered by Sunnah Trust, our mission is to **ignite inspiration** and enable each student to unlock their distinctive abilities fully. At the heart of 'Servitude' lies a commitment to **foster personal growth and development**. Through our carefully curated curriculum, students embark on a transformative path, **honing interpersonal and leadership skills** while boosting their self-confidence. We firmly believe that by nurturing these aspiring minds, we sow the seeds of a **brighter**, **more compassionate future**.



The programme allows students to discover their potential by **developing interpersonal and leadership skills**, increasing their self-confidence and acquiring the motivation and ability to solve problems, resolve conflicts and bring about change. To raise aspirations and self-confidence in our participants, we organise regular trips and visits to various companies. Once our participants have completed the programme, they will be encouraged to utilise all they have learned to serve their communities by developing social action fundraising campaigns.






In the words of the late Nabeel Al-Azami: 'The Prophet famously said "the leader of a people is their servant"- as such a leader should not be self-serving; rather, a leader should take an approach where they seek to serve others. In another narration, the Prophet said: "God will continue to assist His servant, as long as the servant is assisting his brother". Hence, a person is deserving of Allah's help and support when they are in service of others.'

Our Core Values

During the programme, we refer to the teachings of the Prophet and Sunnah Trust's 6 core values:

- 1 Servitude: Serve others by supporting them through hardship and guiding them towards success.
 - 2 Unity through diversity: Our differences bring new skills and experiences to society.
 - 3 Resilience: Never give up on anything; whatever you may be, whatever you may do, give nothing except your utmost best.

 - 5 Ambition: The sky is the limit. Set goals and targets so that every day is better than the day before.
- **6** A Helping Hand: We are in it together. We listen, learn, and develop solutions as a team. Be generous with your expertise, tools and time.
















Programme Specifics

The programme runs annually, from **September to July** and is jampacked with approximately **24 sessions** each year, about 2-3 sessions per month.


We currently have **two cohorts**: **Tower Hamlets** and **Chadwell Heath**. Our Tower Hamlets cohort is on St Paul's Way in Mile End, while our **Chadwell Heath** cohort is in the FITYA Centre. We try to allocate spaces according to the student's closest location and accept preferences made in the application form and cater also to students living in neighbouring boroughs.

Seerah based Curriculum

We are proud to announce that we are a Seerah-based curriculum. We value the teachings of our beloved Prophet Muhammad SAW and embed the **Sunnah** in every session.

At the first session, all students will be given a new copy of Asim Khan and Toyris Miah's <u>The Simple Seerah</u>: <u>The Story of Prophet</u>

<u>Muhammad - Part One</u> and a course booklet for them to keep. Both will provide ample opportunities for the **students to reflect spiritually and personally throughout the year**. Events that feature in <u>The Simple Seerah</u> will be discussed in each session and the course booklet will have set tasks used during the session and others set homework. We want our students to be driven and inspired to act as the Prophet did, nurturing their leadership qualities along the way.





Criteria - Who are we looking for?

We are not looking for the next Malcolm X to join the programme - we are looking to enhance the confidence of our youth, so they can be equipped with the necessary skills to serve their communities and grow.

We are looking for students that match the following criteria:

- ✓ Students aged 13-16 years old;
- ✓ In promoting equal opportunity and the promotion of education for both genders, we welcome Muslims and Muslimahs;
- ✓ Open-minded students;
- ✓ And those wanting to improve on their leadership and general lifeskills.

PHASE 1: September - December Introduction to Leadership

Workshops and trips will be centred around key skills including but not limited to leadership, effective communication and confidence. Sessions include Dealing with Conflict, The Apprentice, our inaugural Muslim Ted Talks and a trip to the University of Cambridge.

PHASE 2: January - June Take the Lead

Students will be encouraged to take the lead.

Public speaking workshops, planning and hosting large-scale events, our Umarah's Legacy Fundraiser and residential trip will take the skills the students have been working on to the next level.

PHASE 3: July Graduation Day

Parents and students will celebrate the progress made by the cohorts across the year.

*Successful candidates will be enlisted.



Next Steps: Hikmah Mentoring

Students who graduate from the Servitude programme can join our **alumni network** and gain access to **exclusive opportunities**, including our esteemed Hikmah mentoring programme.

We are blessed to be connected with an array of Muslims in impressive career fields, who volunteer with us in **monthly 1:1 sessions** with selected mentees to work on their personal and professional development throughout the year.

Alternatively, when our former students are older, they have the opportunity to return to Sunnah Trust and volunteer with us, delivering the sessions they were once taught.



As a leadership programme, we value the different ways in which leadership skills can be developed, hence, **no two sessions will look alike**. Sessions vary from classrooms to workshops, trips to talks and venturing the outdoors. Some workshops act as a springboard for the more practical and team-building sessions.

Whatever the session format, the **Sunnah is always embedded in each activity**: in how the students carry themselves on their different projects, their interactions with the community and how they present themselves as a united youth, essentially capturing the spiritual essence and good moral backing of leadership from an Islamic perspective.

Classroom-based Talks

We sometimes invite **highly valued guest speakers** to provide advice and knowledge in their area of expertise:

- Leadership Knowing Yourself;
- Positivity and Productivity;
- Ted Talk: Being Muslim in the Modern World;
- Dealing with Conflict.

Interactive Workshops

In workshops, students tackle leadership qualities and engage in activities that promote such skills:

- Let's Communicate;
- My Voice, My Power;
- Speak Out Challenge.



Nature and the Outdoors

Given the importance of nature in Islam, we organise **trips to the outdoors**, as a reminder of the beautiful creations of Allah and His power:

- Visit to Willowbrooke Farm;
- Activities at Gripped London;
- Pre-Ramadan Residential Retreat;
- Trek to Snowdonia;
- Visit to Gardens of Peace.

Umarah's Legacy Campaign

Umarah was a student of Servitude and sadly passed away on Thursday 10th August 2022, aged 15. She had many causes and projects close to her heart, from climate change to girls' education and achieved much in so little time. In memory of her goodness, students on the Servitude programme undergo a month of fundraising. In 2023, the students collectively raised over £20,000 for different charitable projects, from sponsoring orphans to building a masjid in Uganda in Umarah's name.



Ramadan

During Ramadan, there are fewer sessions to help the students focus on other priorities they may have in the month. However, they are reminded of the virtue of this blessed time in the follow-up to, and during Ramadan:

- Pre-Ramadan Residential Retreat;
- Iftar Gathering.

Exciting Trips

We want our students to aim high and the way to do that involves **gaining exposure** in areas they typically would not:

- Trip to Cambridge University;
- Vist to Bloomberg;
- Competing in The Big London Bake.

How do I apply for the programme?

If you would like to apply for the programme please contact us via email admin@sunnahtrust.co.uk. All applicants must complete an application form. If the application is successful, students will be invited to attend an interview to assess their suitability for the programme. Please note, the programme is only for young people aged 13-16 years old.

What is the course fee?

The fee for the programme is £200, with a £50 administrative fee and will cover the following:

- All sessions and course materials;
- All trips and transportation;
- Weekend residential.

Is a discount available?

The programme has been heavily subsidised, and along with regular sessions and trips, so unfortunately we are unable to offer any discounts. We can, however, offer further subsidies to those unable to afford the full price. We welcome you to email us at admin@sunnahtrust.co.uk and we will review each case on its merit.








Is there segregation in the classroom?

There is no physical barrier segregating the boys and girls in the classrooms, although they will be seated separately. We expect students to learn and develop the required Islamic etiquette when interacting and engaging with the opposite gender. This will assist them in their current situation at school and/or later in higher education or career. The course aims to instil the values of modesty and good Islamic manners in this regard. Our facilitators and people of knowledge will be leading each of the sessions so they will ensure boys and girls abide by Islamic rules.

During the residential (weekend away) each gender will have their own dormitory and any physical activity will only be with their respective gender, to enable greater participation of physical activity. More details will be provided closer to the time of the residential.



Please let us know on the application form if your son/daughter has any allergies or medical conditions. We will try our best to accommodate the student's needs. If however, we are unable to, we shall be in touch.

My child has special educational needs and requires support.

Unfortunately, we are not in a position to support children with SEN, as this requires a specialist to be with us during all of the sessions.

Do I need to pick up my child from the centre or can they leave when the sessions ends?

It is the responsibility of the parents to decide how best the child gets home.

What if my child misbehaves?

We will give a warning to students who misbehave and will be following the behaviour policy. However, with any incident deemed to be serious, we shall endeavour to arrange a meeting with the student and parents to discuss the best way forward. Please remember to read and sign the behaviour policy which can be found on the course booklet.
